The Family and Descendants David H. and Bonnie Anders

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;Bonnie Anders 38, head of household/born in North Carolina/WidowChildren;Lillie 20, spinner/born in N.C.Pansy 16, spinner/born in N.C.Flossie 17, dwarf hand/born in N.C.Melvin 11, born in S.C.Mary 4yrs.7 months/born in S.C.Helen 3 yrs. 2 months, granddaughter, born in S.C.

David H. Anders died in 1910 and is buried in the <u>Glendale Community Cemetery</u>. Grave marker; David H. Anders, 1843=1910, 25th N.C. Reg. Co. K CSA

<u>The 1940</u> Spartanburg/Glendale Census showed Bonnie was living with her daughter Mary Dunaway. She had married Mason T. Harris but he had died at the age of 65 in March, 1937. No record of his interment.

Bonnie Anders Harris is buried in the <u>Glendale Community Cemetery</u>. Grave marker; Bonnie Anders Harris, May 13, 1878=February 25, 1957.

Melvin is buried in the <u>Glendale Community Cemeterv</u>. Grave marker; Melvin M. Anders- November 18, 1909=November 18, 1978. Fay Brown Anders died at the age of 67 in January, 1980. No marker found
