

Attention Glendale Citizens and Friends

The **iron bridge** owned by Spartanburg County over Lawson's Fork at Glendale is currently scheduled to be restored beginning in early 2017. The restoration is planned to be completed by late June 2018. The restoration will be conducted and managed by the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SC-DOT).

The restored bridge will be for pedestrians and bikes and events of various kinds. It will be exclusively for pedestrians, bikes, and events. No motorized vehicles!

The bridge will be a pearl in Spartanburg County, and it will be a connecting point and gateway for most trails in the area. It will be a "gateway bridge to everywhere!"

Restoration will consist of replacing weakened and missing steel members, stripping and repainting, removing and replacing the worn deck, and adding both dim and bright lighting systems. Small parks are scheduled to be developed at each end of the bridge.
