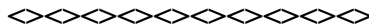




Pearl Harmon Wykell 18 weaver                      Husband, Frank Wykell 21,

The 1880 Spartanburg/Pacolet Census listed the household as;  
Eliphus Harmon 27, husband/ farmer                      Wife; Fannie 32  
Children;    Preston 3                      Florence 5 months

The 1900 Spartanburg/Glendale Census showed they had been married 24 years and were  
the parents of 5 children, 3 living.  
The household was listed as;  
Eliphus Harmon 47, husband/ farmer/ born January 1853.  
Wife; Fannie 52, born February 1848,  
Child; Eva 13, born June, 1886  
No other records were found



The Family of Preston A. Harmon, son of Eliphus and Fannie Harmon;  
Preston married Mary Agnes Koon Harmon.  
The 1900 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;  
Preston A. Harmon 22, husband/born June, 1877                      Wife; Mary A. 22/born April, 1878

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census showed Preston and Mary had been married 11  
years and were the parents of 1 child.  
The household was listed as;  
Albert P. Harmon 32, husband/farmer                      Wife Mary A. 52  
Child;            Elbert C. 9  
Mother; Fannie E. Harmon 62, widow/mother of 5, 3 living.

The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;  
Preston A. Harmon 42/cloth room                      Wife; Mary A. 41, seamstress  
Son;              Elbert C. 18

Grave markers; Preston A. Harmon, June 28, 1877=January 7, 1965

The Family of Marion F. Harmon, son of John P. and Mary B. Harmon of [Pacolet, S. C.](#)  
The 1900 Spartanburg/Glendale Census shows that they had been married 20 years and were the parents of 3 children, 1 living.

The household was listed as;

Marion F. Harmon 46, husband/blacksmith /born in April, 1854.

Wife; M. Henrietta 39, born in March, 1862.

Son; Charles 7, born in March, 1893.

No other records found.



The Family of H. E. and Addie Harmon;

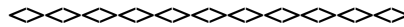
The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;
