## The Family of Walter F. and Delilah Lominac Hutchings

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Walter F. Hutchings married Delilah Lominac.

Walter F. Hutchins 42, husband/machinist

Children; Roy J. 11 Nora M. 9 Ruth M. 6

Harley 10 months

Obituary records show that;

Walter F. Hutchings died at the age of 76.

Delilah Lominac Hutchings died at the age of 79.

Both are buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery.

Delilah L. Hutchings, August 4, 1886=May 16, 1966.

Nora M. Hutchings Bennett died at the age of 86 in May, 1997.

Ruth M. Hutchings married Loyce Elliot Corn, son of Charlie and Susie Crocker Corn.

## Obituary records show that;

**Loyce Elliot Corn** died at the age of 76 in February, 1987.

Ruth M. Hutchings died at the age of 76 in May, 1989.

<u>Loyce Elliot Corn</u> was a first cousin of this writer. He was a welder and helped construct the Cooper River Bridge in South Carolina. Ruth was a weaver in the Glendale Cotton Mill.



Harley Woodrow Hutchings, son of Walter F. and Delilah L. Hutchings; Harley Woodrow Hutchings married Geneva Watkins.

## **Obituary records show that;**

Harley Woodrow Hutchings died at the age of 58.

Geneva Watkins Hutchings died at the age of 62.

Both, along with their two infants are buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery.
