

## The Glendale Keeter Families

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.



The Edward Franklin Keeter family did not move into the [Glendale Community](#) until late 1940s or early fifties.

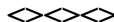
The 1940 Spartanburg/Inman Mills Census showed the entire family having been born in North Carolina. The Household was listed as;

Edward F. Keeter, 36, husband/card room	Wife; Eula 35, spinner	
Children; J. Floyd 16	Alford 14	Myrtie Hazel 12
Eula Faith 8	Donald I. 5	

Obituary records show that;

Edward Franklin Keeter died at the age of 68 in March, 1972.

Eula Estelle Bradley Keeter died at the age of 74 in March, 1979



The Family of James Floyd Keeter, son of Edward Franklin and Eula Bradley Keeter; James Floyd Keeter married Ethel Marie Hall.

No census records found.

They had three boys, Steve , Jerry and Donnie Keeter.

Obituary records show that;

James Floyd Keeter died at the age of 71 in November, 1994.

Ethel Marie Hall Keeter died at the age of 81 in October, 2008
