Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

<u>The 1900</u> Spartanburg Township/Glendale Census shows that they had been married 10 years and were the parents of 4 children.

The household was listed as; John W. Kidd 29, husband, born September, 1870/cloth room overseer

Wife; Addie 32, born August, 1867

Children; Daisy 9, born in May, 1891 George 7, born in July, 1892

Luther 4, born in June, 1895 May 1, born in May, 1899

The 1910 Charlotte Census listed the household as;

J. W. Kidd 40, Cotton Mill Superintendent Wife; Addie 42

Children; Daisy 18 George 16 Luther 14

May 10 Fay 8 Ada 6

John 3

Cook; Lizzie Allshoel 19

The 1920 Paw Creek, N. C. Census listed the household as;

John W. Kidd 50, Cotton Mill Superintendent Wife; Addie 52

Children; Luther W. 24, electrician Faye 18

Ada E. 15 John L. 13

The 1930 Hickory, N. C. Census listed the household as;

Paul Brock 31 Wife; Ada Brock 25

Mother in-law; Addie Kidd 63 Father in-law; John W. Kidd 58

Addie Kidd is buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery;

Grave marker; Addie Kidd; 1867=1953

No record of John W. Kidd's death was found.
