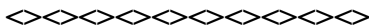


Glendale's "Moore" Families

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.



The Family of Loula A. Moore;
The 1900 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;
Loula A. Moore 51, widow/born January 1849/mother of one child.
Daughter; Carrie 19, weaver/born July, 1880



The Family of Ludella Moore;
The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;
Ludella Moore 33, widow
Children; Calvin 16/spinner William 14/spinner
Nellie 11 McKirby 10

Buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery;
Grave markers; Ludella Moore-September 12, 1855=February 1, 1928
Samuel H. Moore-September 25, 1833=April 26, 1907 (Husband???)
Calvin Moore- May 7, 1893=June 13, 1935



The Family of James and Effie Mae Moore;
The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;
James Moore 33, roping Wife; Effie 24, spinner
Sister in-law; Loice Simmons 15, spinner

Buried in the [Glendale Community Cemetery](#);
Grave markers; James L. Moore-May 8, 1891=January 6, 1965
Effie Mae S. Moore-February 5, 1893=October 21, 1959



The Family of Elbert and Lockie Hunter Moore;
The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;
Elbert L. Moore 39, husband/cotton mill Wife; Lockie 26
Children; Lillie 5 Howard 1 month

The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Lockie Moore 46, widow/spooler

Children; Ellis 17 Thomas 11

Grandson; William 10

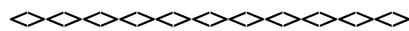
Grave markers; Elbert L. Moore-October 11, 1880=September 20, 1928

Lockie Hunter Moore- May 17, 1893=June 29, 1959

Ellis Moore-July 29, 1921=June 20, 1972

Howard Moore-December 2, 1919=April 13, 1931

Infant child of E.L. and Lockie Moore-May 28, 1918=October 28, 1918
