Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

The Family of Emma Patton;

Emma and her first three children were born in North Carolina, others in South Carolina.

The 1900 Spartanburg Township Census listed the household as;

Emma Patton 39, widow/born April, 1861/mother of 9 children, 9 living.

Children; Richard 26, born May, 1874 Laura 16, born February, 1884

Joseph 14, born February, 1886 Henry 13, born August, 1887

Carrie 10, born November, 1889 Betty 7, born July, 1892

Lilly 5, born June, 1894 Juanita 3, born December, 1896

Sallie 1, born June, 1898

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Emma Patton, 46, widow/mother of 11 children/10 living.

Children; Henry 23 Lilly 16 Junie 15 Sallie 12

Cofer 8 Donnie 7

**Granddaughter**; Annie May 7

Unable to identify Emma's husband.

No records of Emma' Death were found.

James Patton Sr. died in September 1999.

Carrie Long Patton died at the age of 81 in January 1998.
