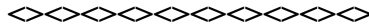


George Pryor

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.



The 1900 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

George married Corrie LeMaster.

George Prior 27, husband/born April, 1873/Spinning Room Overseer

Wife; Corrie 25, born November, 1874

Children; Bessie 4, born June, 1895

Sister; Carrie Prior 26, born October, 1873/warp hand

Aunt; Sarah Lemaster 65, born July, 1834

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Wife; Corrie L. 36

Children; Bessie 14 Melvin 7

Fred 5

Delbert 1 year,3 months.

The 1920 Cherokee Census listed the household as;

George D. Pryor 47, cotton mill overseer

Children; Melvin 16 Freddie 14

Delbert 11 Naomi 8

Woodrow 6 Grace 2

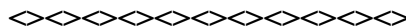
Father; Pink Pryor 70, widower
