Nellie Reaves married Pearl L. Blackwell.**

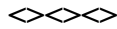
The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Ella Reaves married Walter Messer.

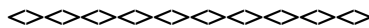
The 1940 Spartanburg/Converse Census listed the household as;

Walter Messer died at the age of 68 in August, 1967.

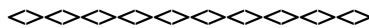


Laura Reaves, parents unknown;

The Family of Barham Reaves, parents unknown;

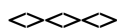
The 1870 Spartanburg Township Census listed the household as;

The 1900 Spartanburg/Arkwright Census listed the household as;

Barnard Reaves 68, born in June 1832 Wife; Mahaley 54, born in December, 1846
Children; Pink 20, weaver/born in May, 1880 Mollie 18, weaver born in February, 1882
Eddie, 17, carder, born in January, 1883

No other records were found.



The Family of Charles Robert Reaves, son of Barham and Mahaley Reaves.

Charles Robert Reaves married Laura Holland.

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census shows that they had been married 14 years and were the parents of 1 child.

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census shows that they had been married 2 years and were the parents of 1 child.

The household was listed as;

Pinkney Reaves 34, husband/weaver Wife; Arvie 21
Son; Marvin 6 months

Grave markers; V. P. Reaves, October 17, 1875=February 9, 1935

Arie Reaves, N=March 22, 1889=February 4, 1920

Marvin F, Reaves, October 7, 1909=September 7, 1975

The obituary of Vernon Pinkney Reaves shows that he was married to Mamie McAbee at the time of his death in 1935.



The Family of Edward “Eddie” Reaves, son of Barham and Mahaley Reaves;

Edward Reaves married Mammie Mosely.

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Edward Reaves 27, husband/cotton mill Wife; Mamie 22
Children; Barm 5 William 3 Eugene 11 months.

The 1940 Spartanburg/Beech Springs Census listed the household as;
Edd Reaves 57 **Wife; Mamie 52**
Sons; William T. 32, weaver Herman B. 18

Obituary records show that;
Edward Reaves died at the age of 65 in December, 1947.
Mamie Mosely Reaves died at the age of 73 in July, 1961.



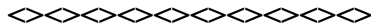
Family of Charles Eugene Reaves, son of Edward and Mamie Reaves;
Charles Eugene Reaves married Betty Howard Hix.
The 1940 Spartanburg/Beech Springs Census listed the household as;
Charles Reaves 30, husband **Wife; Betty 31**
Daughter; Betty Jean 8

Obituary records show that;
Charles Eugene Reaves died at the age of 89 in September, 1998.
Betty Howard Hix Reaves died at the age of 57 in June, 1965.



The Family of Barnham Reaves, son of Edward and Mamie Reaves;
Barnham Reaves married Mary Thomas.
The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;
Barham Reaves 34, husband/weaver **Wife; Mary 31**
Daughter; Dolores 8 Charlotte

Obituary records show that;
Mary Thomas Reeves (Reaves) Pruitt died at the age of 85 in April, 1995.
No record of Barham Reaves obituary was found.



The Family of Joseph “Mack” Malcom Reaves, parents unknown;
Joseph Malcom Reaves married Stella Putman.
The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census shows that they had been married 4 years and were
the parents of 1 child,
The household was listed as;
Mack Reaves 21, husband/cotton mill **Wife; Stella 19**
Daughter; Thelma 1 year, 3 months.

The 1940 Spartanburg/Beech Springs Census listed the household as;
Joseph M. Reaves 51, carding **Wife; Stella 49, weave room**

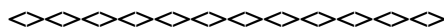
The following persons are buried in the [Glendale Community Cemetery](#) but relationships were not identified.

Temmer Bogan Reaves, January 8, 1892=April 6, 1961

Paris Palmer Reaves, January 22, 1888=November 29, 1961

Obituary records show that a Laura Reaves of [Glendale, S. C.](#) died at the age of 53 in July 1919. I have been unable to find any other records concerning her.
