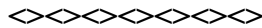


Family of Charles Monroe and Ruby Strother Trombly

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.



The 1940 Cherokee/Limestone Census listed the household as;

C. M. Trombly 62, husband/section man	Wife; Ruby 42, spinner	
Children; Charles 21	Margaret 16	Lewis 13

No other census records were found.

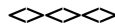
They also had a daughter named Helen.

The Trombly family did not move to [Glendale](#) until sometime after the 1940 Census at which time the spelling was changed to Trombly.

Ruby Strother Trombly, February 27, 1892=July 25, 1972

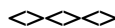


Charles E. Trombly, son of Charles M. and Ruby Strother Trombly;

Margaret Trombly married Rayford Mittag.

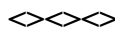

Helen Jeanette Trombly Howell, daughter of Charles M. and Ruby Strother Trombly;

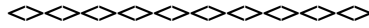
Helen Jeanette Trombly married Elie Howell.
